Delores Helen LeGault (Oct. 15, 1924 - Nov. 24, 2023) passed away peacefully in Rancho Mirage, California, one day after Thanksgiving this year. Delores was a devoted wife to Phillip A. LeGault (an electrician) and mother to their four sons. Emigrating from Duluth, Minnesota, in 1960, the LeGaults lived in Fullerton, San Juan Capistrano and ultimately Palm Desert, California. Delores was a homemaker, substitute teacher, volunteer election worker, artist and sculptor who received a master's degree in fine arts from Cal State Long Beach after completing her undergraduate studies at UC Irvine. Prior to her marriage, Delores worked for the U.S. Treasury in Chicago, Illinois. Her parents, Hans and Ida (née Asperheim) Johansen immigrated from Norway during the late 19th Century. Delores was an active member of Elim Lutheran Church in West Duluth, Minnesota, as well as First Lutheran Church of Fullerton, California. She is survived by her children, Gail P.
